Cascade Clamp - Cascade Manufacturing Company was established in Portland, Oregon in 1943. They began as a small machine shop in the beginning employing 4 people. Sales for their first year of operation amounted to about \$60,000. The first recorded sales revenues involved the assembly and machining of stainless-steel pipe fittings, valves and other parts. Through 5 years of operation, the company had stretched to forty employees and their yearly sales volume had increased to \$330,000. These days, Cascade is amongst the leading international producers in the material handling trade.

Manufacture and design of the company's initial hydraulic cylinder paved the way in Cascade's aggressive quest of new business opportunities. During the past sixty years, the material handling industry has developed into a very sophisticated area and Cascade has proudly played a part on this growth. Cascade at the moment continues to grow as the best supplier of forklift attachments and numerous related items. The company feels confident in their skill in order to continue to lead the way in the business by understanding customer's requirements in the future and remaining competitive in the world market.

Throughout the nineteen fifties, Cascade began to fabricate, design, and sell its hydraulic accessories. A new facility was made in 1956, to be able to accommodate all plant offices and operations in Portland, Oregon, which continues to be the company's present head office. Following 15 years of business, total employees reached a hundred and eighty employees and sales had reached nearly two million three hundred thousand dollars.

In the year 1959 in Springfield, Anaheim the next manufacturing plant was built. 1960 marked Cascade's preliminary transfer into the international world of the material handling industry when the company recognized interest in Australia, the Netherlands and England.

In the year 1964, the business changed its name to the Cascade Corporation. Afterward in 1965, the company went public with an initial offering of two hundred thousand shares of common stock. Ever since then the company has expanded its manufacturing services throughout the continental US to the areas Warner Robins Georgia to go along with its already current plants in Portland, Oregon and Springfield, Anaheim. Cascade products are fabricated worldwide thanks to many subsidiary operations. In 1994, a brand new plant was accomplished in Almere, the Netherlands which is Cascade's European headquarters. This facility is built to be the essential customer support centre.

Continuing to develop, Cascade expanded their product offering further in 1996 and the year 1997 with the remarkable acquisition of five companies, including the international leader in blades, the Kenhar Corporation.
